For the 6th year in a row, The Salvation Army of Livingston County is hosting a program called Summer Lunch Bunch, a summer feeding program for children and their families. The program targets children that have received free and reduced lunches throughout the school year, knowing that during the summer their families do not receive additional income. Therefore the parents have to choose between paying a bill (electric, gas, rent) or providing a meal.

Through this program the children and their families receive:

- A nutritional hot meal on site each week for 8 weeks
- Enough pantry food to provide additional lunches for the week throughout the entire summer
- An educational and fun activity and/or project
- The support of caring adults week after week
- Additionally, if needed, we provide transportation to and from the program site.

Due to the increased need, since last year the program has grown from 3 full services sites and a monthly pantry drop site to 5 day time sites and 1 evening site. Last year the program served over 14,000 meals in just 8 weeks, this year we are projecting to serve over 16,000 meals.
